#### Fiusis: energy and fuel from pruning olive trees

This inspiring project from the Italian Region of Puglia is a biorefinery for energy production. It uses the residual biomass from pruning the olive trees of Puglia's 380 000 hectares of olive groves. It is a great example of real industrial symbiosis with the agricultural sector, making excellent use of crop residues.

#### ZenRobotics – AI working towards a circular economy

ZenRobotics has harnessed the power of artificial intelligence to improve the quality of waste sorting. Their AI-powered robots recognise and sort waste fractions of various shapes, weights and sizes, including materials like plastics, metals, wood and fibres, before converting them into high-quality secondary raw materials.

Public consultation for the EU Taxonomy (including circular economy)



The **European Commission** has launched a public consultation for the <u>EU Taxonomy</u> (including circular economy). This call for feedback on technical screening criteria on circular economy is part of ongoing work by the Platform on sustainable finance, set up by the Commission to provide advice on the further development of the EU taxonomy. The Platform on Sustainable Finance is welcoming stakeholder feedback **until 24 September 2021**.
